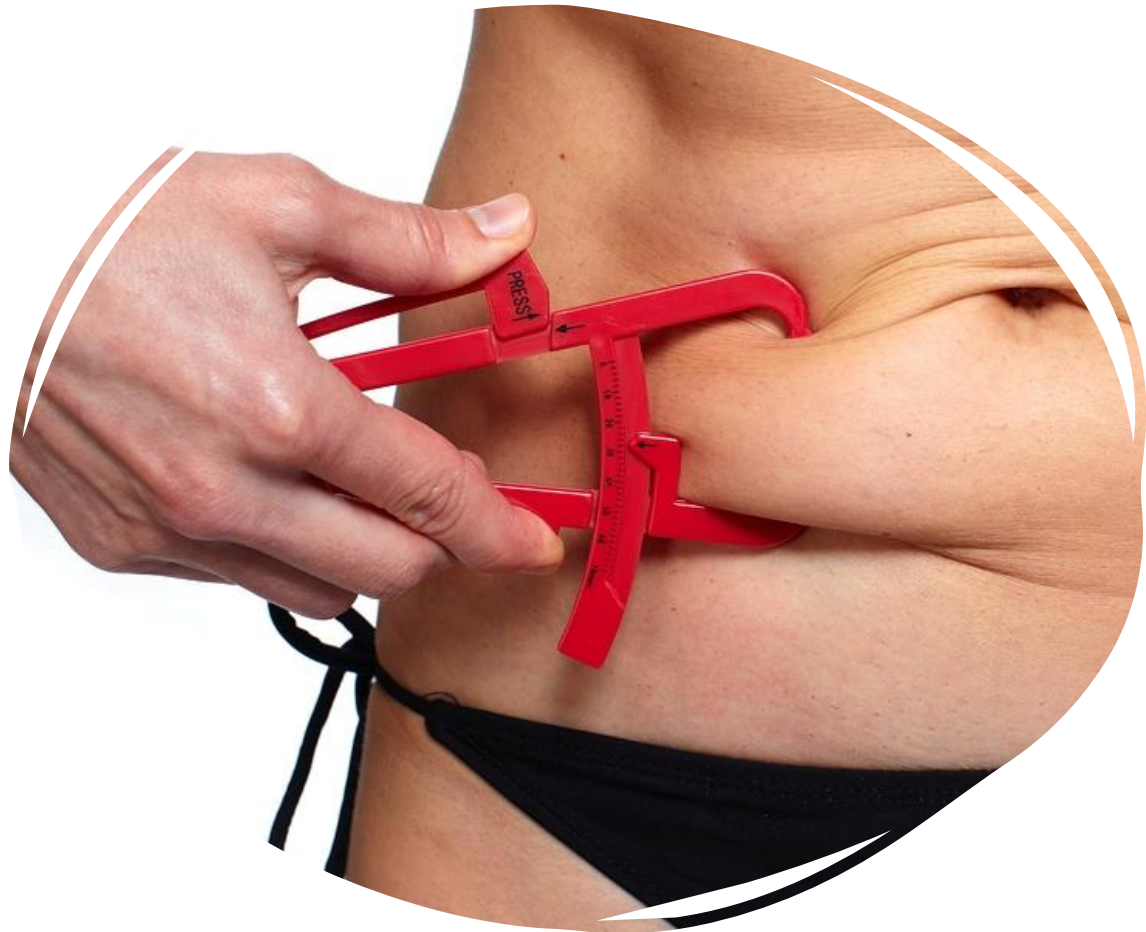

overall EFFECT.



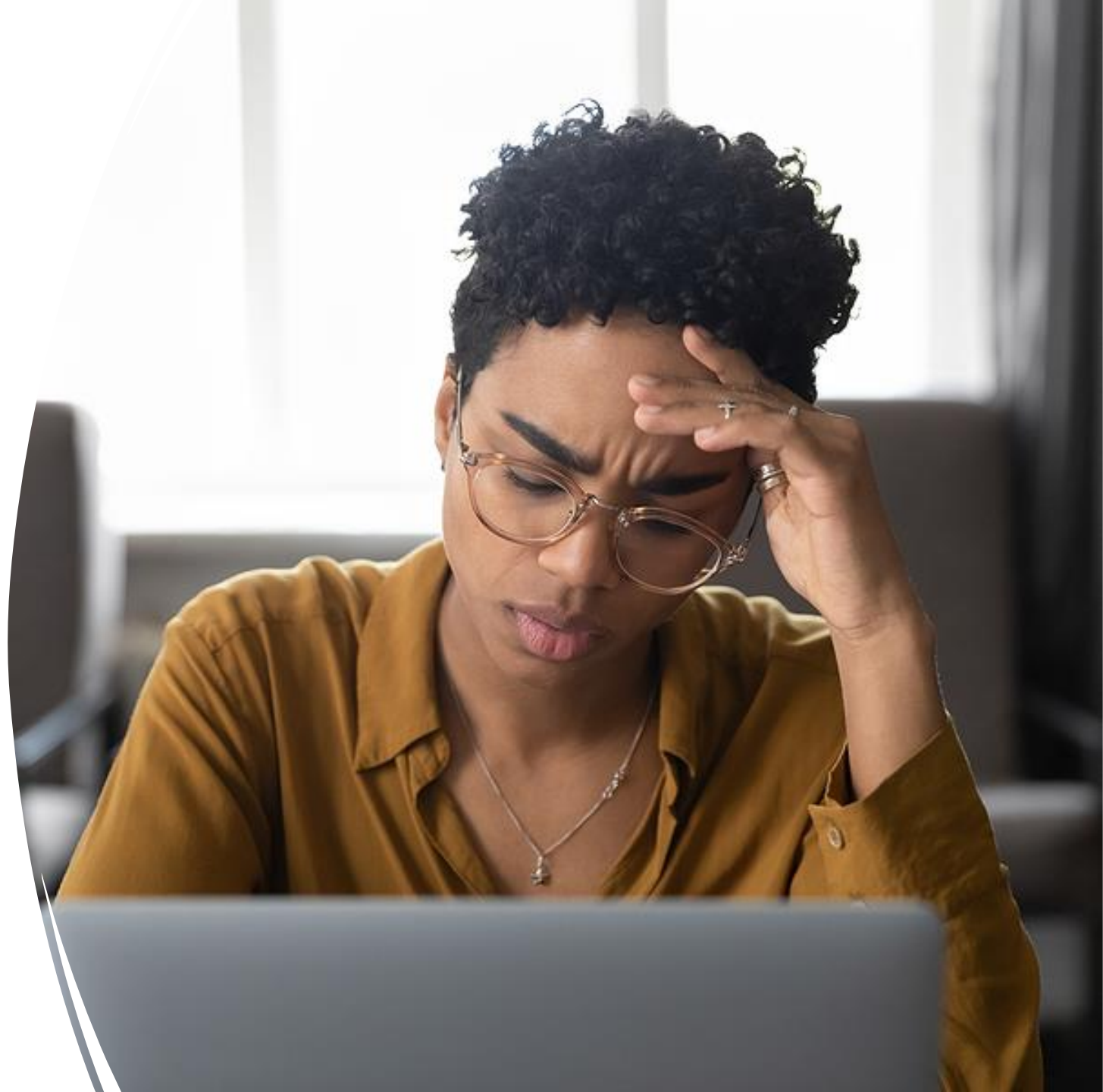
